





Q2 When dining at a restaurant in Bristol, what factors influence your choices?



Q3 If vending machines/concession stands are available at community parks in Bristol, do you think healthy food and beverage options are provided?





Q18 If there was an anonymous, community hotline you could call for support or to talk to someone, would you consider using it?




